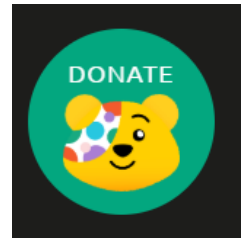

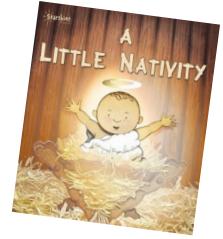

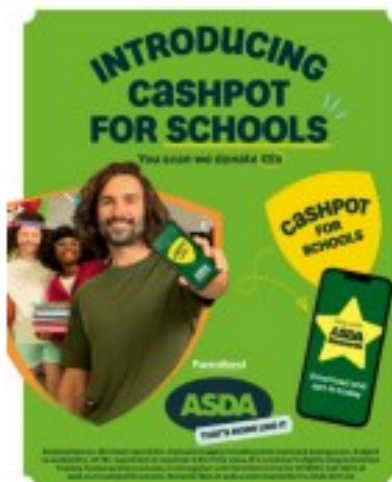
Any donations for bottles including sauces, hair/body products, drinks (soft & alcoholic). Alcoholic bottles will be used in the popular adult tombola.

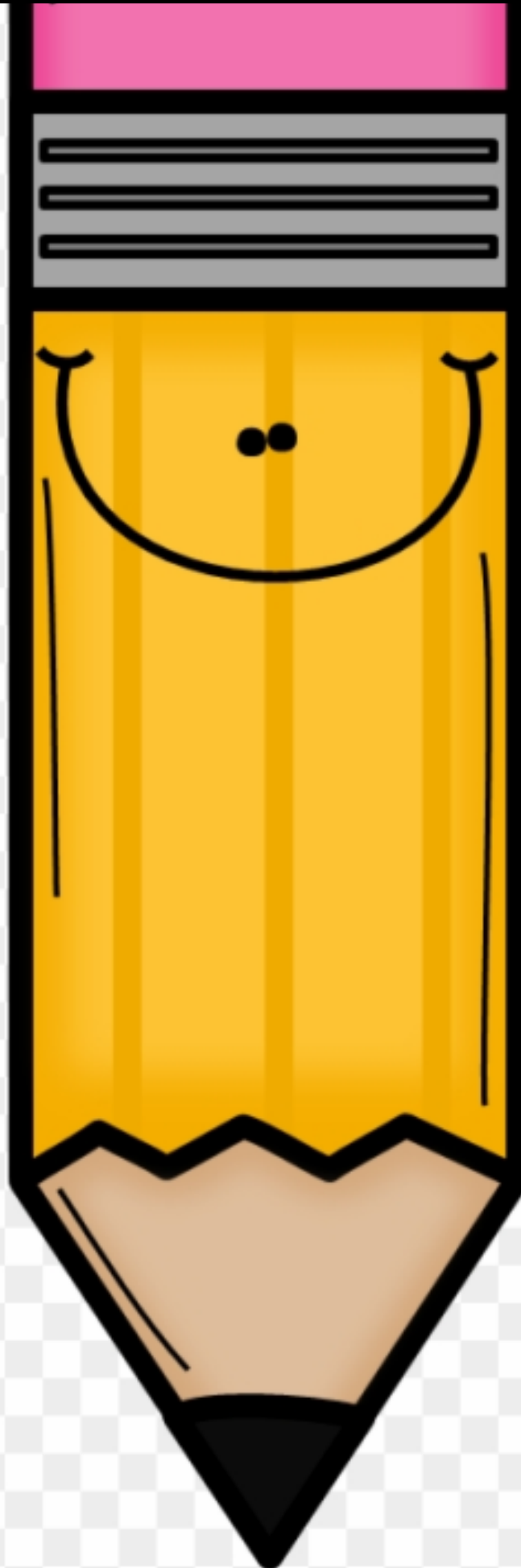

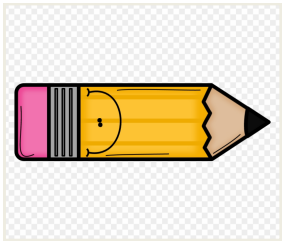

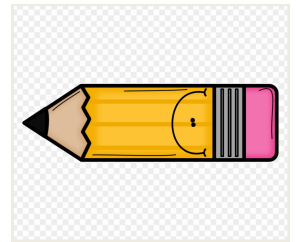


Lateness

The gates close at 8.40 ready for registration at 8.45. If you know you will miss registration, please call the office so we know when to expect you.

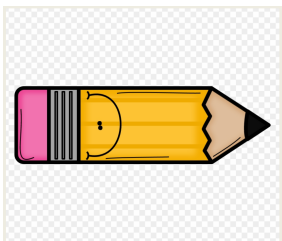

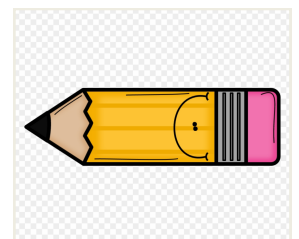
Routine appointments should be booked out of school hours whenever possible. We
